- Owns and operates 10 of India's 20 refineries
- Over 100% Capacity utilisation for the 3rd consecutive year
- Clocked lowest overall specific energy consumption
- Best distillate yield of 75.3 wt% achieved
- Panipat, Haldia, Mathura refineries commence production of BS IV compliant petrol and diesel
- Crude imports of 39 million tonnes in 2009-10
- Combined refining capacity of 60.2 MMTPA
- Combined refining capacity of 1.2 million barrels per day
- Accounts for 34% national refining capacity
