

First 5 Rafale fighters for India, will touch down tomorrow

New Fighters Will Need Time To Be Integrated Into System

New Delhi: So, it's finally jet, so, go! The first five Rafale fighters tore into the skies over France with some bonfire on Monday to begin their 7,000-km flight to India, which will include mid-air refuelling and an overnight stop in UAE.

Two twin-seat omni-role fighters, flown by seven IAF pilots led by commanding officer Group Captain Harkirat Singh, will touch down in Ambala to launch the 17 'Golden Arrows' squadron on Wednesday. After India's ambassador Jawed Ashraf flagged off the five Rafales

from the Morignac airbase in Bordeaux (France), they landed at the Al Dhafra air base in UAE on Monday evening after flying for over seven hours, said an IAF officer. The fighters, dubbed "game-changers" by IAF, will touch down here in the middle of the ongoing military confrontation with China. But top IAF sources played down the "overhype", stressing that new fighters take time to settle down and be properly integrated into the war-fighting machinery.

"No new weapon system, especially complex ones like fighters can be deployed just like that. First the fighters have to be extensively flown in Indian conditions to develop tactics and other operational procedures," said a source.

The new weapon, in effect, takes time to be deployed. IAF has already deployed an adequate number of Sukhoi-30MKIs, MIG-29s and Mirage-2000 in forward areas along the LAC.

"But yes, the effort will be to make Rafales operational as fast as possible due to the border situation with China. It will probably take at least two months," he added.

All the 36 Rafales are slated to be delivered by end-2021.

Another Salary Cut Arrives for IndiGo Pilots, Top Execs

IndiGo's decision casts shadow over other airlines that are struggling for cash

Mumbai: IndiGo has implemented another round of pay cuts for its senior management and pilots, as the airline's business continues to be affected by the Covid-19 pandemic, said a senior executive.

The latest pay cuts—which mean the senior management will get between 15% and 35% lower monthly salaries than pre-Covid times—will be effective September 1, said the executive.

IndiGo's biggest airline recently also decided to lay off 10% of staff.

Chief executive Ronojoy Dutta has taken an additional 10% cut in his salary. He had earlier taken a 25% cut and will now forgo 35% of his monthly pay. All senior vice presidents (SVPs) will take a 30% cut, up from 20% before. VPs will forgo a quarter of their remuneration, up from 15%, while assistant VPs will take a 15% cut, compared with 10% initially.

Pilots who had been safe from the move of layoffs, will now get their salaries deducted by 13%.

The airline has 28,000 employees, 40% of which are pilots and crew.

The decision by IndiGo, the country's richest airline which carries half of India's domestic passengers, casts a shadow also on its rivals, at least two of which are struggling for cash.

IndiGo had total cash of ₹20,377 crore as of end March, more than the combined cash reserves of all its rivals. Last month, IndiGo slashed salaries of some pilots and implemented additional furloughs, continuing the measures it had started in May. The furloughs are till July and the executive mentioned above didn't specify if those would be extended.

Other airlines, too, have been taking stern measures to stay afloat.

Air India earlier this month approved a leave-without-pay scheme for its permanent employees for six months to two years, extending up to five years. The carrier's pilot union has opposed it, saying it had not been consulted.

New Delhi: PVR and INOX Leisure, two of India's biggest multiplex chains, will reduce ticket prices for the first few weeks after re-opening to bring back cinema goers who have spent a major part of the past four months confined to their homes due to the lockdown and other restrictions.
