- Post for Engineering Assistant (T&I) is reserved for Ex- Servicemen.
- The post in Sl No 01 is also suitable for Physically Handicapped persons in OH category i.e. hunchback/deformity of chest. The post at Sl No 02 is also suitable for Physically Handicapped persons in OH category i.e. one arm partially affected/deformity of chest and also in HH category i.e. partially deaf. However such PH candidates will be considered for selection by general standards of merit.

In addition to the Basic Pay, D.A. (present rate of DA being 97.3% of Basic Pay) and HRA, other benefits like Provident Fund, Gratuity, LTC, liberalized medical benefits, productivity / performance linked incentive, leave encashment, superannuation benefits, Post Retirement Medical Attendance benefits etc. shall also be admissible according to the rules of the Corporation.

Application Fee:

Application Fee (non-refundable) of Rs.100/-(Rs. One Hundred only) through crossed Demand Draft in favour of INDIAN OIL CORPORATION LTD.- PIPELINES DIVISION payable at State Bank of India, BR-Campus Branch, Barauni, Begusarai (Bank Code: 1502) should be enclosed along with application form. Any other mode of payment is not acceptable and application not accompanying the application fee will be rejected without any further reference to the applicant.

Concession/Relaxation:

- 1. Upper age relaxation of 3 years for OBC candidates for the post reserved for them. Upper age relaxation of 10 years for physically handicapped candidates (as per rules). Age relaxation for Exservicemen as per rules.
- 2. SC/ST/PH candidates are exempted from payment of application fee.
- 3. SC/ST candidates called for test/interview will be reimbursed single 2nd class railway fare limited to rail fare from the nearest railway station of the mailing address to the place of test/interview and back by the shortest route on production of bus ticket/rail ticket nos. provided the distance is not less than 30 kms. each side.

Selection Methodology:

The selection methodology will comprise Written test, Trade test and Personal Interview of short listed candidates. The candidates will have to pass through each stage including medical fitness successfully for being adjudged as suitable for selection.

General Instructions:

- 1. Service is transferable to anywhere in India.
- 2. Candidates employed in Government/Semi government/Public Sector Organization must send their application through proper channel or produce "No Objection Certificate" at the time of appearing in the Test/Interview. In case the candidate fails to submit/produce the certificate his/her candidature will not be considered.
- 3. Candidates should apply in the prescribed format only (<u>Download Application Form</u>) along with application fees, attested copies of mark sheets, educational qualification certificates, caste certificate recent OBC certificate & physically handicapped certificates (where ever applicable), Ex-servicemen Discharge certificate (for EXSM) and two recent passport size coloured photographs (one to be affixed on the application form duly signed by the candidate).
- 4. Incomplete applications or applications received after the due date will be rejected.
- 5. Candidates from SC/ST/OBC/Ex-Servicemen category should submit their caste/Ex-Servicemen certificate issued by Competent Authority along with the application form, in support of their claim of belonging to SC/ST/OBC/Ex-Servicemen category.
- 6. For claiming the benefit of Physically Handicapped, the candidates should attach Medical Certificate issued by a Medical Board attached to the Special Employment Exchange/Vocational Rehabilitation Centre for PH or Head of concerned Department of a Government Civil Hospital satisfying the prescribed disability criteria (40% of relevant disability).
- 7. The decision of the Management in all matters relating to eligibility, acceptance or rejection of the application, mode of selection will be final and Management will not entertain any enquiry or correspondence in this regard.
- 8. Application of a candidate having higher qualification than the prescribed qualification shall be rejected.
- 9. Canvassing in any form shall disqualify the candidature.
- 10. A candidate should apply for one post only.
- 11. Management reserves the right to fix/increase the minimum percentage of cut-off marks in the prescribed qualification for calling the candidates for test/interview.
